Flower arrangements can be moved off the altar and placed near offices and/or the Brewster Room following the last Sunday service of the day, unless needed for an event (i.e., concert). If requested and available, they can also be wrapped and given for deliveries to shut-ins or given to the designated memorial family of that day.
- Please make sure the **altars (and floor beneath) are left clean.**
- Sacristy should be left in good order: vases and flower containers cleaned, dried and put away, floor swept, etc. Let next team know if there are left-over flowers/greens.
- Can use Greens/garden flowers (hardened) from June (after Trinity Sunday) - September unless there is a memorial or wedding (the office will notify us of these events).
- A small arrangement for the Peace Altar each Sunday would be nice.

\* Rose-colored flowers may be used for the fourth Sunday in Lent.

\*\* Crosses should be veiled in purple.

+ Decorate Paschal candle until Pentecost.

\*\*\* Last day for the Paschal candle.
